## Key Principles



Vaccinating as fast as possible to reduce morbidity and mortality



<u>Simple</u> prioritization: initially aged 60+, medical staff, first responders (now 16+ excluding recovered patients)

Marketing and fighting fake news to encourage vaccine compliance + Minority focused campaigns

## Procurement

National procurement scheme with multi-Ministry cooperation including the Prime Minister's Office, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Defense, etc.

- Coordinated through the Ministry of Health's COVID-19 Command Center
- Negotiations were opened with suppliers early, contracts closed ahead of regulatory approval
















## Lessons Learned – **Technology** is Key, and Data is Power



Inter-operability and smart decision-making based on data and Big Data



Technological tools were vital in targeting patients through integrated National Immunization Registry and HMO EMRs and communications systems



Monitoring effectiveness and Side-effect tracking



Inventory planning and avoiding waste through integration with HMO appointment tracking systems



Documentation and the green pass program



# **Lessons Learned**



Call center for vaccination professionals

– administration guidance, clinical
questions, and shipment information



Need to create smaller cases for distribution



Training EMTs and Paramedics to administer the vaccine has added surge capacity



Hospital and ER units – well-prepared + Scaling + Well-equipped (oxygen, ventilators, flexible solutions, remote care)

Syringes and needles supply
